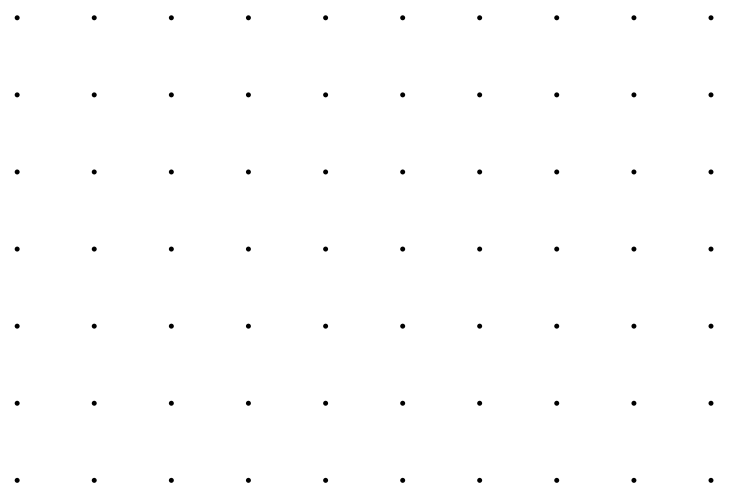

- Any equivalent qualification.

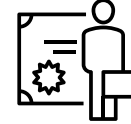

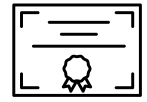
