


1. How to Access EvaluationKit Survey

How to Access EvaluationKit Survey Tool

1. To access EvaluationKit, please login to your Canvas.




Once login is successful, students will see a pop-up box (if they have surveys currently available).
This pop-up prompt will display each time the student re-login to Canvas if the student has not complete their survey.




3. To proceed to the survey, students may click on to the 'Go To Survey'. If the students decide not do the survey at that particular moment, they may click 'Do It Later'. Students clicking on 'Do It Later' will be able to close the pop-up and continue their session in Canvas.

<u>PLEASE BE INFORMED</u> that this function is to be <u>TURN-OFF</u> at a later stage of the survey period. Therefore, students are *strongly suggested* to complete their survey in order to avoid future inconvenience.


4. Clicking on 'Go To Survey', students will be directed to survey dashboard where all of their surveys are displayed. Active surveys have a live link, and completed surveys display the date and time that the survey was completed.



5. When the student clicks on the survey link, they will be presented with a dialogue box which lists the teaching staff in the unit. Students are to select their respective lecturers / instructors listed. Click 'Next' to proceed.




6. Once the lecturers / instructors are selected, the survey is generated. Unit questions are now presented at the beginning of the survey, along with the best aspects and improvement aspects of the unit.




- 7. After the unit questions, the student is presented with list of questions for each of the teaching staff selected (Step 5). If a student hovers the cursor over a particular radio button, the survey displays the question, radio button value and lecturers/instructors' name, to assist students to select the correct respond.
- 8. After the questions for each staff member, the survey presents the students with a comment box for each staff member.



9. The student can click 'Previous' however the data is not transferred until the form is submitted.



- 10. Students completing the survey and click **'Submit'**. Prompt message on the confirmation of submitting the feedback will pop-up.
- 11. Once the student clicks on **'Submit'** button a completed surveys display the date and time that the survey was completed.



12. Students completing the survey will receive email notification to confirm that the survey was successfully submitted.




